



Drama Kids of NE Dallas, Rockwall, S. Collin and Denton Counties will abide by all state and local guidelines, in accordance with coronavirus-prevention protocols. Drama Kids will also list safety measures below that may be relaxed or tightened based upon program experience and state and local guidance as outlined.

Drama Kids Camp/Class Safety Guidelines

- **Curbside Drop Off:** All parents will be required to drop off students at a predetermined location, where a Drama Kids staff member will meet and collect all participants before entering the building.
- **Temperature Monitoring:** All participants will have their temperature taken by a Drama Kids staff member, by a touchless thermometer, upon arrival each day. Any student with a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or more, will not be allowed to participate in the program and parents will be contacted for pick-up.
- **Wash Hands Upon Arrival:** All participants will be required to wash their hands each day upon arrival.
- **Social Distancing:** Each participant will be positioned in the classroom with a minimum of 6ft between each child. Participants will be encouraged to maintain social distancing at all times.
- **Personal Protection Equipment:** All Drama Kids staff members will be required to wear a form of PPE while in contact with participants. Participants have the option to wear or not to wear a form of PPE while participating in the Drama Kids program.
- **Static Grouping:** To the extent possible, participants and Drama Kids staff will maintain static groupings, keeping the same sets of participants with the same staff throughout the camp/class experience.
- **Hand Sanitizer Available:** Hand Sanitizer will be made available for all participants and staff and is encouraged to be used as necessary.
- **No Sharing of Materials:** There will be no sharing of materials, which is including but not limited to: props, writing utensils, worksheets, snacks, drinks, etc.
- **Wash Hands Prior to Departure:** All participants will be asked to wash their hands prior to their departure. Ample time will be provided to complete this task prior to parent pick-up time.
- **Curbside Pick Up:** All participants will be picked up outside the building, in a predetermined location. The Drama Kids staff member will stay with all participants until the final pick up has been made.
- **Final Parent Presentation:** The final parent presentation will be recorded and emailed out to families upon completion of the camp/class.
